Ca' del Console Prosecco Extra Dry- A classic Prosecco with aromas of white peach, pear and flowers. The palate is fresh, not too dry, and clean as a whistle all the way through to the sparkling finish.

Ca' del Console Prosecco Rosé - A fragrant, fruity, delicate sparkling rosé wine with flavours of strawberries, raspberries and passionfruit.

Champagne Laurent-Perrier- Well defined, subtly rounded with expressive flavours. The fruit progressively emerges to reveal a finely balanced champagne displaying great length on the finish.

Champagne Laurent-Perrier Rose- Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens to provide a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries. It has great length and is rounded and supple on the finish.

First Fleet Chardonnay- A delicious Chardonnay that captures the pioneering spirit of the first voyages to Australia in a crisp, modern style. Red apple and melon fruit fills a palate that is dry yet well rounded, making this a versatile accompaniment to food.

Picpoul de Pinet Beauvignac- Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, and a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.

Featherdrop Sauvignon Blanc- Lively aromas of gooseberry, passionfruit, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalize the palate and provide a refreshing clean finish.

Mahi Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc- Pure class, flavours of lemon-lime, pepper and herbs, plus a subtle suggestion of ripe peach. Plush and broad but with harmonious spicy, grapefruit notes giving the wine lift. Fresh but fully ripe and nicely tactile, even plush, and long on the aftertaste.

Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier- Fresh citrus on the nose, with a palate of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.

Chablis, Jean-Marc Brocard- Fresh, classic nose with notes of green apple, hawthorn and minerals. Crisp on the palate while displaying good depth of flavour, and a long, dynamic finish.

Poggio Alto Pinot Grigio Rosé- With a delicate pale pink colour and an elegant nose of acacia flowers, this light-bodied dry rosé is delightfully refreshing.

Mancura Etnia Merlot- An inviting deep ruby-red in colour, this wine is packed full of ripe blackberry and plum aromas with delicate hints of spice and crushed black pepper. The palate is succulent, soft and fruity.

Nazets De Saint Victor, Côtes du Rhone, Foncalieu- This historic blend is full of dark red fruit flavours, smooth and easy in style. Rich, hearty berry fruit aromas lead to a beautifully balanced, medium-bodied palate, with the exuberant fruit lifted but some peppery spice.

Promesa Rioja Crianza- A classic style of Rioja, with strawberry, blackberry and rhubarb fruit flavours taking on a vanilla and cocoa smoothness during twelve months in oak barrels.

Fleurie Clos des Quatre Vents, George Duboeuf- Full-bodied for Fleurie, with plenty of oomph to match the trademark floral character, and complex nuances, both savoury and fruity, on the palate.

Château Montaguillon, St Emillion- An expressive nose of roasted plums, dried herbs and fresh earthy notes leads to a medium-full, currant-infused palate of both breadth and focus.

Chateauneuf-du-Pape Le Parvis, Ferraton- A dense wine, with notes of sour cherries, plum, roasted coffee and leather. Fleshy, with fine and rounded tannins that coat the palate and carry on through the long, savoury finish.

Gevrey-Chambertin Les Crais, Jean-Michel Guillon- This Gevrey shows really lifted, vibrant berry fruit on the nose, backed up by real presence and structure in the mouth. Full and velvety, it is very impressive village-level wine.

Morandé Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, half bottle- Rich, fresh and complex, this late-harvest wine balances sweetness with intense quince fruit and notes of orange peel. Full and honeyed in the mouth, but always with that citrus cut of Sauvignon Blanc, this is a versatile match for a great many desserts as well as blue cheese.

Norton Cosecha Tardia half bottle- Harvested late in the season, the Cosecha Tardia (or Late Harvest) is bright golden yellow in colour. Aromas of flowers and peaches on the nose follow through onto a rich, ripe palate with balanced, fresh acidity and a pleasant finish.
